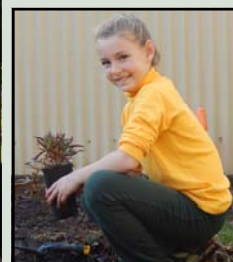
Jeni—I liked meeting our local heroes and learning new things that I didn't know before.

CONGRATULATIONS to the following people who received a **'Certificate of Recognition'** at our Education Week Assembly—

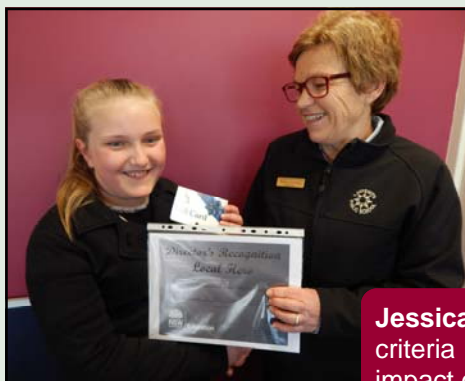
Stewart Cole—for providing assistance and guidance in Athletics (accepted by Rebecca).

Thank you to Fleur Muller for organising these uniforms.

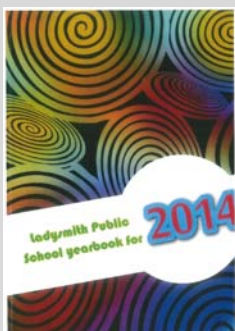
